After we looked at pizzas and what makes a good pizza. We completed activities designing our own pizza using mathematical shapes and counting toppings!

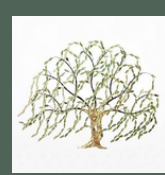
We then made our own pizzas!

TT ROCKSTARS

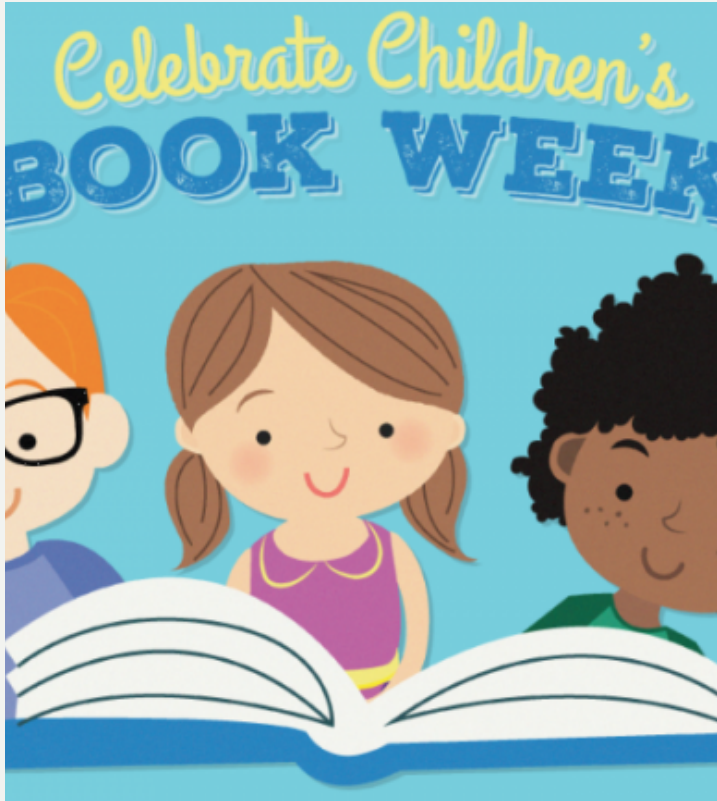
